RULES:

- Enter through Gate #4.
- All entries must be owned and registered in the name to the exhibitor.
- Cattle must be on grounds by 10:00am and must remain on grounds until 5:00pm.
- The maximum total eligible exhibits from a breeding unit are 10 head. For Junior Female Classes, exhibits per breeding unit are restricted to a maximum of 2 exhibits in a maximum of two classes. There is no restriction on multiple exhibits for milking female classes.
- For the purpose of the 2022 Dairy Cattle classification, an entry shall be interpreted as follows: All registered dairy cattle, whether owned by ONE person or by MORE THAN ONE person, which are maintained on one farm or one breeding unit, are considered to be production of one farm or unit. Only ONE entry per class is eligible from such a farm or breeding unit, except as authorized above. Where the same interests are involved in more than one breeding operation, such operations are considered one breeding unit.
- Space in barn will be on first come first served basis.
- Rosettes will be provided for Junior & Senior female champions.

SECTIONS:

1. Junior Calf – Born March 1 to May 31, 2022
2. Winter Calf – Born December 1, 2021 to February 28, 2022
3. Fall Calf – Born September 1, 2021 to November 30, 2021
4. Spring Yearling – Born March 1, 2021 to August 31, 2021
5. Fall Yearling – Born September 1, 2020 to February 28, 2021
6. Junior Herd – Three homebred heifers from one farm
7. Two year old - Born September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020
8. Three year old - Born September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2019
9. Four year old - Born September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2018
10. Mature Cow - Born prior to September 1, 2017
11. Breeder's Herd (bred and owned by exhibitor). Group of three animals. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the classes for single animals. Registration certificate for each respective animal must show the exhibitor as "Breeder" and as "Owner" in both cases either as an individual or in partnership. All the animals must be from one farm or breeding unit.
12. Best Udder Class – Judge shall designate best three udders in Sections 8 to 10. Prize money to be paid on first place only.
